


## Assignment Types


Step 1 in Gradebook setup is to create **Assignment Types**. Click on Settings to display Assignment types.


This setup screen allows you to create assignment types (see examples below). The system allows you to create as many assignment types as necessary for you to properly categorize and weight assignments in each of your courses.




