I. Parameter Maintenance

1. Overview

IPASS system parameters enable the system administrator to customize the environment that **IPASS** is operating in. There are multiple system parameters that are controlled through this console, some pages have their own menu options (i.e. Transcript Parameters). Parameters are broken down into **Applications, Parameter Groups, Parameter Names and Parameter Values**. These field value pairs allow for quick customization at varying levels the software. Each **Application** can have multiple **Parameter Groups** and **Parameter Names**.

Parameters are categorized in 5 groups:

a. Team

b. School Specific Parameters

These parameters are controlled at the school level allowing for customization at the school level. (i.e. Attendance, the number of days a user can enter past attendance for a given school. Different school may have different past attendance policies).

c. Module Specific

d. Page Specific

e. Reports



Changes made to the Parameter Maintenance affect the entire system. Please ensure that you know what changes you are making and document those changes.

2. Team Parameter Group

a. Buttons

These are the images associated with the buttons for all of the forms that users interact with throughout the system (i.e. Submit and Cancel). Buttons are stored your web server in a virtual directory. See parameter group (Team, System, Page Defaults, Image Base).



If you wish to make your own buttons please do not overwrite the existing images with your own, add them and change the parameter name.

b. Class

All of the fonts on the web pages within **IPASS** are controlled by CSS (Cascading Style Sheets).

- xxii. **TD.Alert** - Alert font for displaying message (i.e. Entering daily attendance for a day other than today)

- xxvi. **TD.MENUITEM** - Left hand navigation menu font

- xxviii. **TD.PGTITLE** - Main frame page title font
- xxix. **TD.SMLABEL** - generic small table cell label font throughout the system.
- xxx. **TD.SMTEXT** - generic small table cell label font throughout the system.
- xxxi. **TD.UPDATE** - Update message font after submit or post
- xxxii. **TH.HEAD** - Table Heading Font
- xxxiii. **TH.SMHEAD** - Small Table Heading Font

c. JobTypes

d. Maintenance

Controls the Parameters associated with maintenance specific tasks. (i.e. biographical maintenance the number of records displayed and the number you may add at one time.)

- i. **Number of Add Rows** - The number of records you may add in one submit.
- ii. **Number of Rows** - The number of rows displayed per page
- iii. **Row BgColor** - The table row background color (an array comma separated in hexadecimal format)
- iv. **Row BgColor Error** - The table background color when an error is encountered.

e. Mass Updates

Controls the ways in which the mass update functions.

- i. **DOE Maximum Rows** - No longer used
- ii. **Enroll Maximum Rows** - The maximum number of records to query on Mass Enroll Students page
- iii. **Lockers Maximum Rows** -The maximum number of records to query on Mass Update Lockers page
- iv. **Students Maximum Rows** -The maximum number of records to query on Mass Update Students page.

f. MSB (Master Schedule Builder)

- i. **Can Not Teach** – Day Period cell background color for a period when a teacher has been flagged as "Excluded Periods:" from teacher maintenance screen.
- ii. **Room Conflict** - Day Period cell background color for a period when room has a conflict.
- iii. **Teacher Conflict**-Day Period cell background color for a period when teacher has a conflict.

g. Page Defaults

- i. **Body bgcolor** – The background color of the main frame in hexadecimal format.
- ii. **Column Header Row bgColor** - The alternate background color of sub-column headings.
- iii. **Image Base** – Relative path to ipass images directory located on web server.
- iv. **Logo File** – Ipass logo image file
- v. **Table Align** Default table alignment.
- vi. **Table bgColor** Default table background color.
- vii. **Table HeaderRow bgColor** Default table header row background color.

h. Purge

Determines how long **IPASS** should retain certain data.

- i. **Default** - If not other values exist for this parameter group then the default value will be used, in days.
- ii. **PageHit** – The number of days to retain html counter statistics for a given system.
- iii. **ReportDue** - The number of days to retain submitter reports.
- iv. **SchedulerHist** - The number of days to retain Schedule run information.
- v. **WebState** - The number of days to retain session specific data (i.e. login cookie session data).

i. Query

The methods used in querying, searching the database on search screens.

- i. **DefaultMaxRows** - If not other values exist for this parameter group then the default value will be used on all search screens. There are page specific parameters that override this value.
- ii. **SelStudent** – The maximum number of records to query while pre-selection values on student search screens.
- iii. **UseMaxRows** – Use to control performance in large sites. Determines whether or not to query all database records regardless of **DefaultMaxRows**.

j. Scheduling

- i. **Increment Priority Value on Adding Requests** – If **Set Priority on Adding Requests = Yes** then we automatically increment request priority on adding student requests.
- ii. **Number Add Alternates** – The number of alternate requests you can add for a given request.
- iii. **Number Add Requests** – The number of requests you can add for a student.
- iv. **Set Priority on Adding Requests** - **yes/no** - Determines whether or not you are editing the course request priority.
- v. **Use Period Order** - **yes/no** – On Student schedules and teacher schedules determines whether to use Period display order value or Period Abbreviation value.

k. Search

- i. **casmsbmain.html Number of Rows** – The number of rows displayed on Master Schedule Search Screen.
- ii. **Error Row BgColor** – Search Screen Error background color
- iii. **grdinputgradesclass.html Number of Rows** - The number of rows displayed on Grade Input Screens.
- iv. **Next Link** – The text value for “Next” link on search Screens
- v. **Next Link Type - Text/Image** – Determines whether an image is used or text.
- vi. **Number of Rows** – The number of search rows displayed
- vii. **Prev Link** - The text value for “Prev” link on search Screens
- viii. **Prev Link Type - Text/Image** – Determines whether an image is used or text.
- ix. **Resault Row BgColor** – An array corresponding to the alternating background row color


I. Security

Controls password strength and integrity.

See Secuity System, Password Parameters.

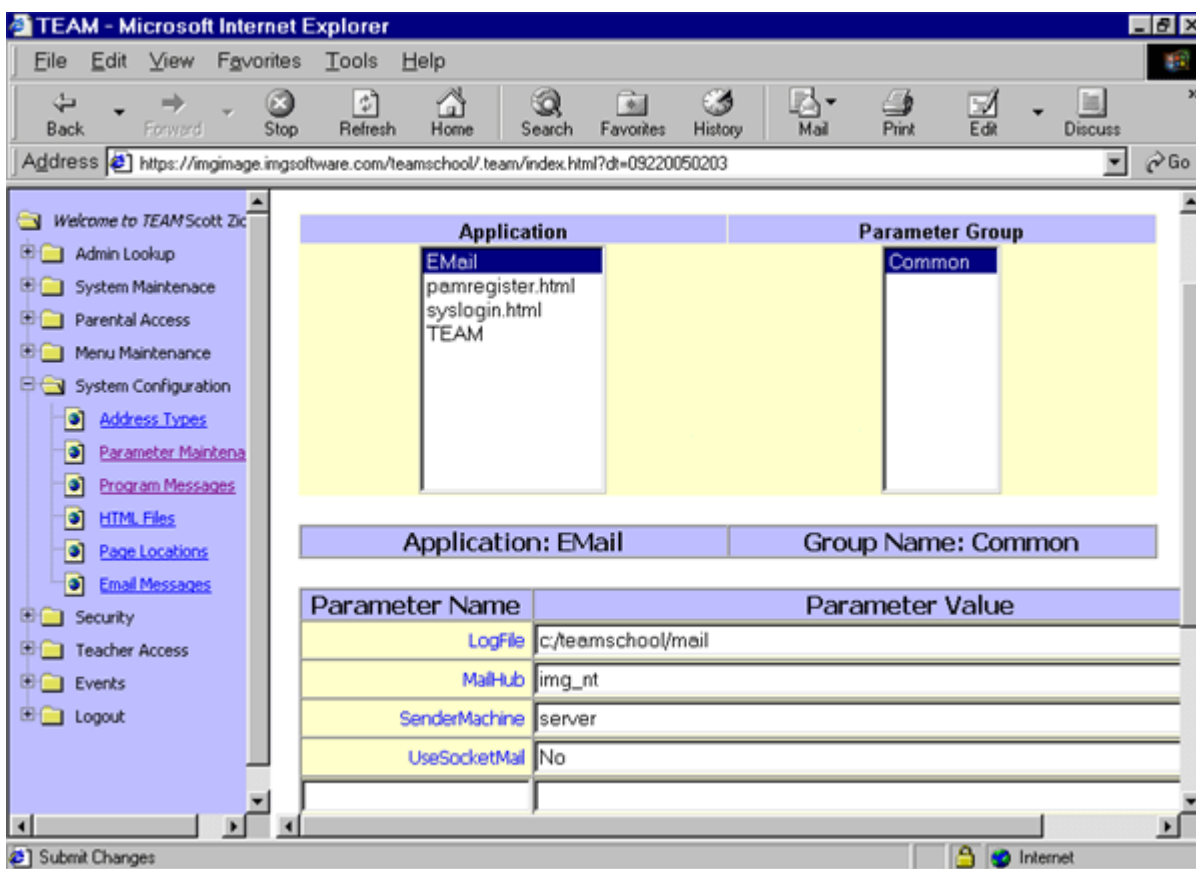
- i. **Minimum Password Length** – The minimum length a password can be.
- ii. **Password Cannot Include User ID – Yes/No** – Determines if the password can contain the users’ id.
- iii. **Password Expiration** – The length in days a password is valid before the system forces the users to change the password.
- iv. **Password Requires Mixed Case** – Yes/No Determine if the password must be mixed upper/lower case.
- v. **Password Requires Numbers** Yes/No Determine if the password must be contain an integer.
- vi. **Password Requires Special Characters** - An array comma separated containing charaters that must be used in a user’s password.

m. System

- i. **Account Admin Email Address** – The email address of the administrator.
 - ii. **Address:Home** – Unique key to determine Home Address Type
 - iii. **Address:Mail** - Unique key to determine Mailing Address Type
 - iv. **Address:Work** - Unique key to determine Work Address Type
 - v. **Base Domain** – The base domain of the website. Used to set session cookie.
 - vi. **Counselor** - Unique key to determine jobtype of counselors.
 - vii. **Create LASID** – Used to auto generate the LASID of a new student. Studentid + DistrictCode + SchoolCode.
 - viii. **CurrAcademicYear** – The default Academic year

- ix. **DefaultState** – The dafault state when adding an address
 - x. **From Email Address** - The from address fro system generated emails
 - xi. **Index Page Allow Resize - Yes/No** – Determines if the end user can resise the frame set.
 - xii. **Index Page Border** - The border width of the main frame.
 - xiii. **Index Page Percentages** – The Menu and Main frame size in Percent
 - xiv. **Lock Retries** - The number of times the transaction server will attempt to access a locked record
 - xv. **Log Page Hit – Yes/No** – Retain webpage requests.
 - xvi. **Menu Background Color** - The background color of the menu frame.
 - xvii. **Num Tabs** - The number of horizontal tabs in a tabmenu
 - xviii. **Right Frame Name** - The Name of the main frame.

- xix. Session Timeout – Yes/No** Determines if a default timeout is set globally for all users.
- xx. Session Timeout Minutes** - Default session timeout in minutes
- xxi. Update Message** – A message the will be displayed on all pages.
- xxii. Use Extended Registration** – Currently not being used.
- xxiii. Use Frames Yes/No – Determines whether or not to use a frameset.**
- xxiv. Version** – The current version of IPASS.

3. Email

Email is sent by default to operate on a Unix machine using sendmail. Other environments that allow socket connections may be setup.

LogFile:

The logfile contains all of the email transactions that take place and should be cleared periodically.

MailHub:

If you are using socket connections, the mailhub (where the smtp client is located) must allow other machines (SenderMachine) to send form it.

SenderMachine:

This is the machine that will be making the socket connection to the mailhub via an API. Port 25 is the port that is required to be open in order to send the system mail command.

UseSocketMail:

A logical (yes/no) that dictates whether your environment is using socketmail.

4. Pamregister.html

Common

The registration process for guardians is controlled through the pamregister.html webpage. This allows you to determine which fields you require guardians to enter in the application for access:

Display SSN:

Social Security number can be made required by the school administrator through a logical.

Send Administrator Email:

Specifies whether or not the system administrator receives an email when a potential user registers. (see need info???)

Table HeaderRow bgcolor: The table header background color.

Format is in hexadecimal #ffffff

System:

System parameters are the core of the **iPASS** system. The administrators email address and the base domain of the program are located here.



Changing system parameters may cause your iPASS system not to function properly. Please consult your software vendor.

Account Admin Email Address: This is the email address of the administrator who will be maintaining the system.

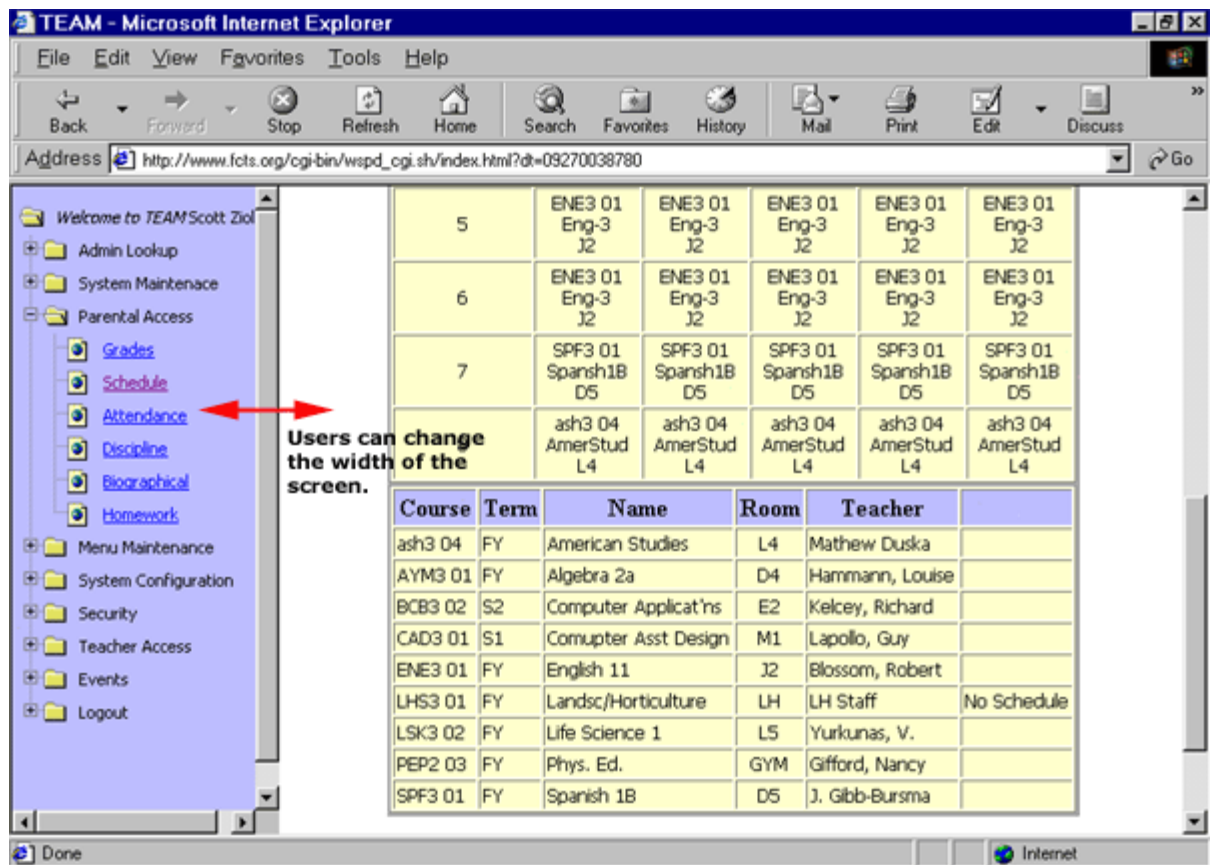
Base Domain: The base domain associated with the url. This is where the system sets the session cookie for individual users while they are logged in.

From Email Address: The email address that is used to send notifications and administrative responses. Your SMTP mail server must allow for this account to send mail using this address.



Using a different email address then the admin email address is a good idea. Also, you may wish to not have this email address accept email responses. If this is true you should state this in your email messages.

Index Page Allow Resize: Allow users to resize the frames windows on the navigation side.



Index Page Boarder: Changes the boarder size of a table on the index.html page.

Index Page Percentages: Changes the navigation bar on the left and the main contents screen on the right, respectively.

Format is in percentages values are comma separated: 22%,78%

Lock Retries: The number of times the transaction server will attempt to access a locked record.

Default value is 10



This value should not exceed 10.

Menu Background Color: The background color of the menu screen.

Right Frame Name: Then name of the main contents frame.



If you are using iPASS within your own frames you may experience errors if the frame names have the same name.

Session Timeout: The session time out is a logical that can be set to yes or no. A user will timeout out if they exceed the session timeout in minutes while being inactive. Inactive is defined as not posting a http request or response.

Session Timeout in Minutes: The duration of time in minutes used for session timeouts.

Use Frames: This allows you to use frames or not to use frames (html).
