


### APPLICATION ENHANCEMENTS

#### Online Course Recommendations

A new option to configure Online Course Recommendation options by Grade Level has been added to the Recommendation Configuration screen. This allows sites to restrict the settings by Grade Level so they can open and close Online Course Recommendations at different times for different students.

Scheduling System > Maintenance - Scheduling > Recommendation Configuration



This new functionality allows users to configure by Grade Level:


- Departments
- Number of Electives
- Departments for Electives
- Sign Off Message
- Default Settings for Recommendations to Requests, Recommendations Approved, and entering/displaying Alternates
- Recommendation Settings:
  - Year to display for recommendations \*(Associated with Grade Level selected.)
  - o Parent Recommendation Access
  - o Message when Recommendations are Off
  - o Parent and/or Student Can Add Recommendation
  - o Parent and/or Student Can Enter Alternates
  - o Columns to Display to Parent and/or Student

**NOTE:** All Grade Levels must be selected, configuration options selected, and the screen <u>submitted</u> to set up the Recommendation Configuration.



#### IMPORTANT NOTE - GRADE LEVEL SELECTION:

The "Grade Level" selected at the top of the Recommendation Configuration screen is related to the year selected for "Year to display for recommendations" under Recommendation Settings.

- When setting up Online Course Recommendations for the NEXT School Year, set Grade Level = <u>NEXT</u> Grade Level and the Year to display for recommendations = <u>NEXT</u> School Year.
- In the event you want to configure Recommendations for the CURRENT School Year, set Grade Level = CURRENT Grade Level and the Year to display for recommendations = CURRENT School Year.

### **Recommendation Configuration Across Schools**

When setting up Recommendations for incoming students coming from another school within the district (ie. Grade 8 middle school recommendations for Grade 9 high school), both the <u>current AND</u> <u>next year Grade Level</u> must be set up for the NEXT School Year selected. For example:

#### Middle School:

- Recommendation Configuration must be set up for Grade Level = 08 and Year to display for recommendations = NEXT School Year.
- Recommendation Configuration must be set up for Grade Level = 09 and Year to display for recommendations = NEXT School Year.


### High School:

- Recommendation Configuration must be set up for Grade Level = 08 and Year to display for recommendations = NEXT School Year.
- Recommendation Configuration must be set up for Grade Level = 09 and Year to display for recommendations = NEXT School Year.

### **Online Course Recommendation Default Parameter Moved**

The Online Courses Recommendation configuration parameter for "Default Unapproved Parents/Students/Teachers recommendations to Approved" (Yes/No) has been removed from Maintenance - Scheduling > Recommendation Configuration and moved to the System Configuration > Parameter Maintenance > Application = TEAM and Parameter Group = Scheduling. This district-wide parameter Default = Yes. This will maintain the recommended parameter setting to the default of Yes unless determined in special circumstances it should be set to No.




### **Guardian CORI Check**


A new option to add Guardian CORI Check information has been added to the Personal Information section of the Guardian Record. A Guardian CORI Report can be run to find Guardian CORI status and Last CORI Check date. This new functionality allows end users to:

- Indicate if the Guardian has a CORI (Yes/No)
- Enter the Date of Last CORI Check
- A "Guardian CORI Date" report allows end users to find CORI information for all guardians or for selected student guardians.



# **Application Improvements and Corrections:**

### Drop/Add Report


The Drop/Add Report "Date" column has been updated to reflect "Date/Time" the course was added or dropped. The addition of the time stamp will help identify the sequence of Drop/Add events on a particular date.



## **Clever Export**

Export Clever Objects report has a new report parameter checkbox for "use School State Code." When selected the School ID will be the School Code and State Code together. When not selected, the School ID will be the current School Code. Also added is a "Key Student ID" filter allowing the end user to select SASID or LASID for students.

### **Gradebook - School Year Access**

Teachers can now select previous and future school years in My Courses > Gradebook view.



### **Gradebook - Dropped Students**

The My Courses > Gradebook class roster now clearly identifies which students are "Dropped" and which students are Withdrawn. My Courses > Gradebook will also only show students in the terms that they were active in the class. The Total Enrolled in the class will not include students that dropped the course during the term.

• When the Drop/Restore feature is used to drop a course, students who have been DROPPED from a class will show with a red # symbol to the right of their name.



Students who have been WITHDRAWN from school will show with their names in red font.



#### Notes:

- Withdrawn students and dropped students will only display if the Teacher Preference setting for "Show Withdrawn Students" is selected.
- In almost all cases, if a student is withdrawn from school they will also be dropped from the class, so it should be rare to see a student's name in red font without the # symbol, but it is possible.



## **Period Attendance - Dropped Students**

The **Enter Period Attendance** class roster will reflect only students actively enrolled in the course. When the Drop/Restore feature is used to drop a student from a course, the student that dropped the course during the term will no longer be listed <u>as of</u> the course "Drop Date." The Total student count at the bottom of the screen will not include students who dropped the course during the term.
