APPLICATION ENHANCEMENTS

Application Improvements and Corrections:

SIF Reporting Changes – School Safety and Discipline Report (SSDR)

- **Reporting Emergency Removal with Extra Suspension Days**

The Massachusetts DOE discontinued the Extra Suspension Days field that was previously used to report extra suspension days after an emergency removal. To accommodate this change, the extra suspensions days beyond the removal will now be reported as an additional consequence in the incident record.

If the first Consequence entered into the Discipline Incident record is a Removal Consequence code linked to Disciplinary Action Taken State Code of 5 or 6 (Removed by school personnel to an alternative setting *or* Emergency Removal), iPass will send the second Consequence to the DOE to report the extra days.

For example, to report an Emergency Removal plus Extra Suspension Days, the user will enter two Consequences; one for Emergency Removal (max of 3 days) and one for Suspension.

• Reporting Victims

Certain Report to DOE Offense Types codes require a victim be reported (Codes 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 12, 13, and 17). SIF SSSDR transmission requires a victim be entered into the Discipline Incident records, not just a number entered into the Number of Victims field. To accommodate districts that do not want to send the victim name or do not record victims in iPass, districts need to select one of the following methods to report victims.

Victims Recorded in iPass – Do Not Want to Report Name to DOE:

A parameter has been added to allow districts to choose NOT to report the victim’s name associated with a Report to DOE = Yes Discipline Incident. Setting the parameter of “Report Victim’s Name” to = NO will NOT send any name entered into the Additional Victim field and will send only the victim count.

Setting the parameter for Report Victim’s Name:

- YES – Any name entered under “Additional Victim” will go to the DOE in the SIF SSSDR XML (Default setting).
- NO – Only the word “Count” and the Number of the Victims will go to the DOE in the SIF SSSDR XML.

Victims Not Recorded in iPass – Need to Report “Nameless” Victim:

If the district chooses NOT to name a victim in the iPass Discipline Incident record, a “nameless victim” must be entered.

First, the user must set the Report Victim’s Name parameter to No (see above).

Next, the user will enter one or more student or staff “nameless” victims to the “Other Person” section.

The user will click on the + symbol to open up the Other Person section.

The user should click on the magnifying glass to search for previously entered nameless victims. If someone in the district has already created one, it will be listed. If the user needs to enter multiple nameless victims, the user will select (or create) Student 1, Student 2, etc. Once created, the nameless victims will be available to select in other discipline incidents. The user will click on the ID Number to add the victim selection to the Other Person table.

Recommendation: It is recommended that districts begin entering nameless victims with an ID numbering and naming scheme. After being created once, the victims will be available to select going forward.

In the example above, student victims were entered with Last Name = Victim, First Name = Other, and Middle Name = Student 1. This makes it easy to identify. The ID Number is made up and should be different than the district's Student ID numbers. If the user needs to report multiple nameless victims, the user will create another one with Student 2, Student 3, etc. Staff can be set up the same way.

Note that Offender or Victim, Gender and Race/Ethnicity fields should be adjusted as they relate to the victim in the specific discipline incident.

The update gave access to these tab options to the User Type = District Super User only. It will be up to the District Super User to give access to other User Types. Give the User Type the Biographical Student > Programs Tab Menu View option and/or the View Only Access – Biographical > View Programs Tab Menu option.

504 Plan Student Indicator

The Print Class List report will now print a tilde symbol ~ for 504 students to differentiate 504 from the Special Education asterisk symbol * when printing on a black and white printer.

When the report is run with Flag SPED/ELL = Yes, symbols will print in front of the student name for Special Education (*), ELL (^), and 504 (~). The report default setting is Flag SPED/ELL = No and will NOT print the symbols.

NOTE: The 504 flag is triggered by the DOE034 field “504” code; the Special Education flag is triggered by the DOE034 field; the ELL flag is triggered by the DOE026 English Language Learners Program field.

Special Note: A future patch release will make a similar change to the Gradebook/Rankbook class roster view. Plans to add Flag SPED/ELL Yes/No to other attendance and course list views and reports will be considered.

The College Board is requesting schools print the registered trademark symbol ® on student transcripts when listing AP courses and SAT/ACT tests.

The user can now use the Alt-Key 0174 (Number Pad) key sequence to add the registered trademark symbol to a Course Name or Test Name.

IMPORTANT STEP: To update Transcripts, Transcript History and Report Cards, a change needs to be made to the PCL form and Transcripts will need to be run for all students.

First the user needs to go to System Configuration > PCL Documents and click on the form to update the Default Symbol Set = ISO 8859/1 Latin1.

Next, the user needs to run the Transcript report for past years for each grade level (all students) with Enrollment set to “All.” The Transcript History will now show the registered trademark. When you run a Transcript for a student, the Transcript and Report Card will show the registered trademark ® symbol next to the course.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If the transcript shows the symbol followed by a U or other symbol, please contact the iPass Support Team to run a script to set the Characters to be correct on the Course Maintenance Table, or, the district's Web Server will need to be set to a default Font Symbol set.
