Why am I getting SSDR errors of "Invalid file headerâ€□, "Too many elementsâ€□, and/or "Incorrect sizeâ€□ when trying to upload my Offense and Discipline files to the DESE?

The text entered in the Description fields $\operatorname{can} \widehat{\operatorname{at}}^{\mathbb{T}} \operatorname{t}$ contain commas and $\operatorname{can} \widehat{\operatorname{at}}^{\mathbb{T}} \operatorname{t}$ exceed 50 characters in length (ie. Description of Offense Type 1-5, Incident Description, Education Services Comment). The upload file is a Comma Separated Value (CSV) so a comma will break the data into more fields than allowed. The best practice is to keep the comment brief with no punctuation. The purpose for this field is to provide an explanation of any $\widehat{\operatorname{at}}$ offense code selection or to explain Education Services provided/not provided.
